Statistical Genetics Faculty Positions in Genetic Medicine

The Department of Genetic Medicine at Weill Cornell Medical College invites applications for both tenure-track and research-track faculty members with expertise in the area of statistical genetics and genomics. The position(s) are at an open level (instructor, assistant, or associate professor) depending upon the qualifications of the candidate. Candidates with experience in a range of areas will be considered although of particular interest are applicants with a strong background in the integration of high-throughput genotype, gene expression microarray, and phenotype data aimed at determining the genetic bases of complex traits.

A doctoral degree in statistical genetics, biostatistics, computer science or a related field is required. The rank of the appointment will be commensurate with experience but new PhDs or MD/PhDs and recent postdoctoral fellows are encouraged to apply.
